

STUDENT CHARTER

Ivy League Charter

Version 1.2 · Effective 29 September 2026 · Replaces versions 1.0 and 1.1

For Master's and MBA applications to the universities on the ILC list (Annex A: the Ivy League, the Ivy Plus, the Public Ivies and the Little Ivies that take graduate students), with other US universities on the same list. This is the agreement between Axelis Overseas Education Pvt Ltd ("Axelis") and you, the student.

1. What we do for you

- Profile evaluation, and a shortlist of programmes at universities on the ILC list (Annex A), balanced with other US universities. The list becomes your locked preference list on the status tracker.
- Essay and SOP strategy with feedback on every draft, a US-format résumé, guidance on letters of recommendation, and mock interviews for programmes that interview.
- Application submission; scholarship, fellowship and assistantship applications where offered; education loans through 25+ lending partners.
- I-20, SEVIS and F-1 visa filing with a mock visa interview, housing assistance and pre-departure support.

2. What you pay

GST is added on top of each fee and itemised on your Cashfree receipt. Not included, and paid by you directly: test fees (GRE, GMAT, TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo), university application fees, the SEVIS fee and the visa fee.

3. When your money comes back

No offer from your preference list. The ₹19,999 service fee is refunded in full if no university on your preference list, on the ILC list or not, makes you an offer.

Your preference list must contain at least five universities, at least two of them from the ILC list.

Visa refused, and not down to you. Half of the success fee you have paid (₹90,000, with the GST on that half) is refunded if your F-1 visa is refused for a reason not attributable to you.

Half, because US student-visa refusals are common and the admission work is complete by then. Nothing is refunded if you have deferred the offer to a later intake.

Approved refunds are paid to the original payment method within 14 days.

4. When it does not

- You receive an offer from any university on your preference list, on the ILC list or not.
- You defer an accepted offer to a later intake. The success fee stays due and none of it is refunded, even if a later visa is refused.
- You leave the process yourself after the first shortlist has been shared.
- You decline an offer from a university on your list. The service fee is not refunded; a success fee is due only if you accept an offer from the ILC list.

No admission, scholarship, fellowship or visa is guaranteed. Axelis is not affiliated with, endorsed by or acting for the Ivy League or any university named in this charter; their names describe where we apply on your behalf.

5. Your part

1. **Preference list.** You rank the universities you want on the status tracker. Once you confirm, the order is locked. The same list appears in your student portal.
2. **Only the list counts.** Refunds are assessed against the universities on your preference list and nothing else.
3. **Genuine information.** Every document and detail you give us must be true. Forged documents, fraud or defamation end this agreement and may attract liability under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, including Sections 316, 318 and 336 to 338.

6. Law and disputes

This agreement is governed by the laws of India, including the Information Technology Act, 2000 and the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. Disputes are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh.

7. Electronic acceptance

This agreement is executed electronically. By ticking "*I have read and agree to the Ivy League Charter*" and completing payment on the Axelis Cashfree checkout, you confirm that you have read and understood it, including the refund conditions, and that the information you entered is true. This is a binding electronic signature under Section 10A of the Information Technology Act, 2000. No physical signature is required. Your name, phone and email as entered at checkout form part of this agreement.

Payments are collected through Cashfree.
