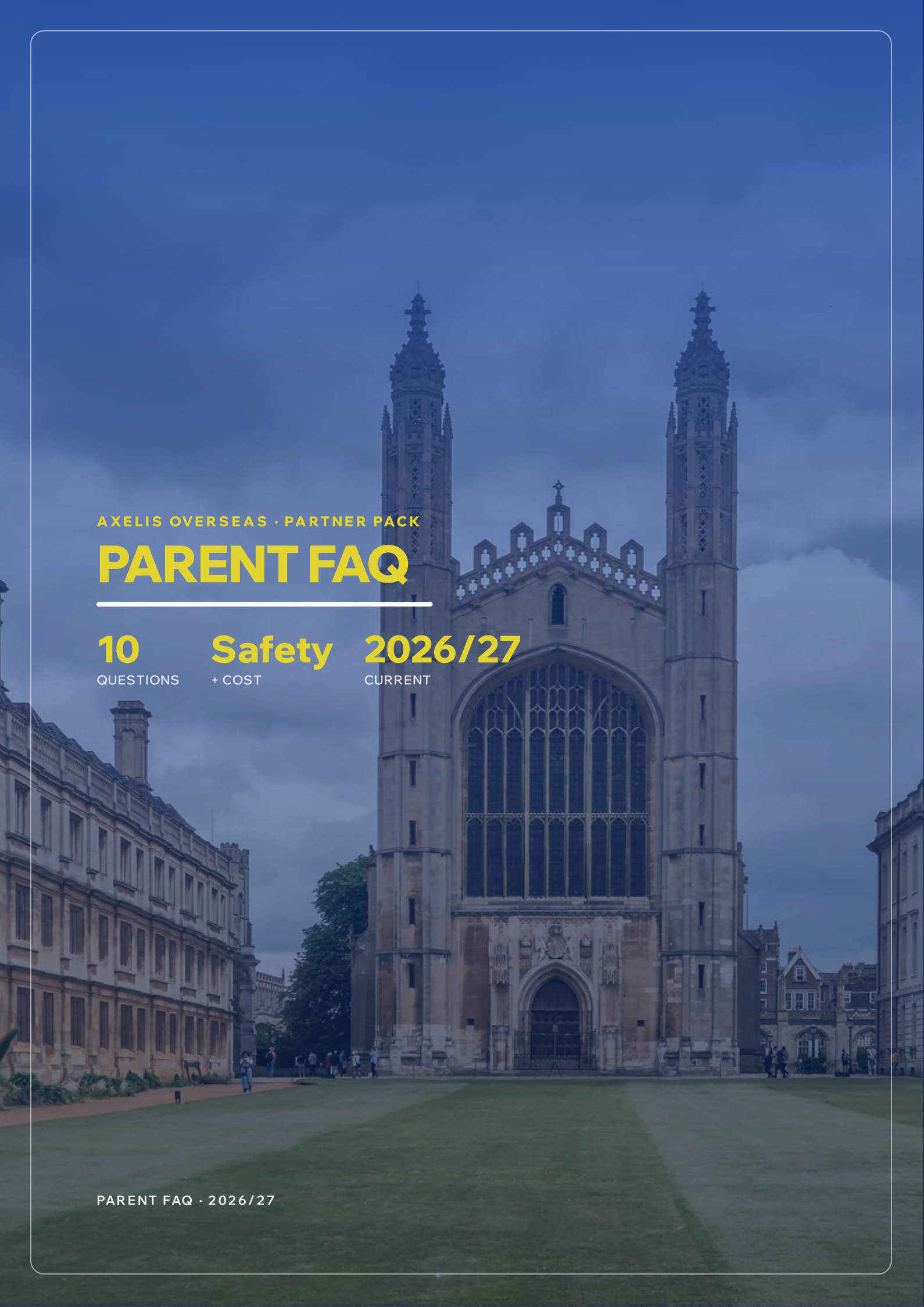

FOR PARENTS — PART 1

Will my child be safe?

Axelis refers students only to accredited institutions in safe, well-regulated destinations, and supports them through arrival and settling in.

How much will it cost?

It varies by country — from tuition-free public universities in Germany to higher-fee destinations like the USA. See the [Tuition Fee Comparison and Cost of Living Guide](#).

Are scholarships available?

Yes — most destinations offer merit and government scholarships. See the [Scholarship Guide](#) for options by country.

Can my child work while studying?

Most destinations allow 15–28 hours a week during term (e.g., 20 hrs UK, 24 hrs Australia). Details are in the [Visa Checklist](#) and country brochures.

What about accommodation?

Options include university housing and shared private flats; the counsellor helps students arrange it before travel.

FOR PARENTS — PART 2

What happens after graduation?

Most destinations offer post-study work stay-back — from 6 months (Switzerland) to 3 years (Canada, NZ, USA STEM). See the University Comparison Charts.

Is health insurance included?

Health cover is mandatory in most destinations and is arranged as part of the visa/enrolment process.

Who supports my child abroad?

Axelis provides pre-departure guidance and remains a point of contact; universities also have international-student offices.

How do I know the university is genuine?

Every partner university is accredited by the national quality body — see the University Accreditation List.

How much money must we show for the visa?

Each country sets a proof-of-funds figure — listed per destination in the Cost of Living Guide and Visa Checklist.
