FOR STUDENTS — PART 1

How do I choose the right country?

Balance budget, subject strength, work rights and post-study options. Start with the Country Comparison Guide, then the country brochure.

What are the basic eligibility requirements?

Typically 12 years of schooling for UG or a bachelor's for PG, plus an English test. Exact requirements are on each brochure's admission page.

What English score do I need?

Usually IELTS 6.0–6.5 (UG) or 6.5 (PG); TOEFL, PTE and Duolingo are widely accepted. See the English Language Requirements guide.

When should I start applying?

6–9 months before your intake — earlier for scholarships and visa-heavy destinations. See the Intake Calendar.

How much will it cost in total?

Tuition plus living plus proof of funds — all summarised per country in the Tuition Fee Comparison and Cost of Living Guide.

FOR STUDENTS — PART 2

Can I get a scholarship?

Yes — merit and government scholarships exist for most destinations. See the Scholarship Guide.

Can I work while studying?

Most destinations allow part-time work (15–28 hrs/week in term). Details in the Visa Checklist.

What documents do I need for the visa?

A standard set — academics, test scores, offer, proof of funds, passport and health checks. Full list in the Student Visa Checklist.

Can I stay and work after graduating?

Most destinations offer post-study work visas from 6 months to 3 years. See the University Comparison Charts.

Who helps me through the process?

Your Axelis counsellor manages shortlisting, applications, offers and visa guidance end to end.
